"Edit Frame" button takes user back to edit screen with the same frame selected that was currently playing in the slideshow or paused on.

Save button becomes disabled when slideshow has been saved and no changes have been made, telling user it is safe to press home button.

Program starts with first frame selected. Touching a frame selects it. Number in parenthesis next to time is current frame length.

When move is selected, the currently selected frame disappears and turns into a thin gold line. User can then press between any visible frames to move the gold line that represents frame currently being moved. User can also use the scrubber to move along timeline to view all possible move locations

Pressing dropdown box drops down possible save folders. If folders are not applicable, remove this option and only leave the save as box. If the phone supports multiple formats, allow the user to select which format to export as, if applicable.
